ORDER ENTERING JUDGMENT

1. On September 28, 1994, the Board received the parties' JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT. The motion encloses a STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT concerning VABCA No. 4000 executed by the parties on September 27, 1994.

2. The parties recite that the dispute which is the subject of the appeal in VABCA No. 4000 has been "amicably resolved" and jointly move that the Board enter Judgment "in accordance with the terms of the Stipulation, in favor of P.J. Dick, in the amount of \$898,207." The parties further recite that this "amount represents a complete and equitable adjustment to this appeal and includes all costs, both direct and indirect, including attorneys fees and interest."

3. Inasmuch as the parties have fully resolved this appeal, the JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT is **GRANTED** and the appeal of P.J. Dick, Incorporated under Contract No. V101C-1679 is **SUSTAINED**. Appellant is found entitled to \$898,207 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Stipulation of Settlement entered into by the parties.
