ORDER ENTERING JUDGMENT

1. On February 13, 1996, the Department of Veterans Affairs and Appellant filed a JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT. The motion encloses a STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT finally executed on February 8, 1996, entered into by the parties concerning VABCA-4649 through 4653, and 4766 through 4787.

2. The parties recite that they have reached "amicable resolution" of the issues which are the subject of VABCA-4649 through 4653, and 4766 through 4787 and jointly move that the Board enter Judgment in the amount of \$346,602 which "includes all costs, both direct and indirect, including attorney's fees but not interest." The Stipulation further provides that interest "will be paid in accordance with the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. § 601-613, on the amount of \$45,000 commencing January 1, 1996, and on the amount of \$301,602 commencing December 11, 1992."

3. Inasmuch as the parties have stipulated the equitable adjustments due The George Hyman Construction Co., Inc. in VABCA-4649 through 4653, and 4766 through 4787, their Joint Motion for Judgment on Stipulated Settlement is granted. Appellant is found entitled to \$346,602 plus interest pursuant to the terms and conditions of the STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT entered into by the parties.
