ORDER ENTERING JUDGMENT

1. On June 26, 1997, the Department of Veterans Affairs and Appellant filed a STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT executed on June 26, 1997, concerning VABCA-4799-4801.
2. The parties recite that they have reached amicable resolution of the issues which are the subject of these appeals and jointly move that the Board enter Judgment in the amount of \$200,000 "in full and complete settlement of the claims in the appeals in question, whether known or unknown, (including attorney's fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act)." The STIPULATION further provides that VA will grant ARB 87 calendar days of time.
3. Inasmuch as the parties have stipulated the equitable adjustments due ARB in VABCA4799-4801, the Government's MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT is granted. Appellant is found entitled to \$200,000 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT entered into by the parties.
