ORDER ENTERING JUDGMENT

1. On June 16, 2000, the Department of Veterans Affairs and Appellant filed a JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT. The motion encloses a STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT finally executed on June 15, 2000, entered into by the parties concerning VABCA-6243-6247 & 6250-6296.
2. The parties recite that the issues that are the subject of these appeals have been "amicably resolved" and jointly move that the Board enter Judgment in the amount of \$850,000 which "includes all costs, both direct and indirect, including attorney's fees but not interest. The STIPULATION further provides that interest "will be paid in accordance with the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, 41 U.S.C. § 601-613, commencing February 19, 1992, the date the contracting officer received Appellant's certified claim."
3. Inasmuch as the parties have stipulated the equitable adjustments due J.F. O'Healy Construction Corporation, in VABCA-6243-6247 & 6250-6296, their JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT is GRANTED. Appellant is found entitled to \$850,000 plus interest pursuant to the terms

and conditions of the STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT entered into by the parties.
