**ORDER ENTERING JUDGMENT**

1. On June 1, 2002, the Respondent, Department of Veterans Affairs and the Appellant, Bradford F. Englander, Liquidating Trustee under Liquidating Trust For Dulles Networking Associates, Inc., in the above-referenced appeals filed a JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT. The MOTION encloses a STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, both executed on May 28, 2002, entered into by the parties concerning the appeals in VABCA-6473-74, 6571-73 and 6753-6758.
2. The parties recite that they have entered into the STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT as a result of non-binding Alternative Dispute Resolution proceedings conducted by the Board on April 17 and 18 2002 in the above-referenced appeal and jointly move that the Board enter judgment in the amount of \$2,700,000, inclusive of interest under the CONTRACT DISPUTES ACT, as the total sum due and payable to Appellant under the above referenced contracts.
3. Inasmuch as the parties have stipulated the amount due Appellant in the above referenced appeals, their JOINT MOTION FOR JUDGMENT ON STIPULATED SETTLEMENT is **GRANTED**. Appellant is found entitled to \$2,700,000 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT entered into by the parties.
