

Why Contact Us?

The OIF/OEF Program offers case management and advocacy services to all veterans who have served in combat since November 11, 1998 and are transitioning to civilian life.

Case Managers will provide:

- Individualized care for your readjustment needs
- Professional short-term counseling
- Assistance with scheduling and accessing services
- Contact assistance for VA services near your home
- Information on VA and community services and resources

Transition Patient Advocates will:

- Provide information and assistance regarding health care benefits and eligibility
- Information about veterans benefits
- Assist veterans in understanding rights and responsibilities
- Assist veterans, families and VA staff in coordinating VA services
- Resolve complaints and concerns

What We Offer

VA Medical care is available to veterans who recently served on active duty in Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF), Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF), or the Global War on Terrorism (GWOT) theaters of combat.

Frequently requested services by OIF/OEF veterans:

- Orthopedic care
- Hearing examinations
- Mental health/adjustment counseling
- Dermatology care
- Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) screens
- Women's Clinic

Other services available:

- Immunizations
- Physical examinations
- Substance abuse treatment
- Surgical
- Health education programs
- PTSD treatment
- Physical therapy and rehabilitation
- Dental (1st 90 days after active duty)

VA Healthcare Benefits

- FREE medical and/or mental health care for 2 years from discharge from active duty for conditions possibly related to your service, regardless of your income status
- FREE dental care within in 90 days of discharge from active duty. Must have 90 consecutive days on active duty.
