Jamie L. Rhudy, PhD is an Assistant Professor at The University of Tulsa. Dr. Rhudy's work broadly spans issues in Health Psychology. However, a majority of his work is focused on determining how psychological factors, specifically emotion, can engage endogenous circuitry known to alter pain processing in the central nervous system. Dr. Rhudy's research uses laboratory-based, experimental methods to measure pain and nociceptive (neural processing of pain) processes from physiological responses.
