RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 2008-047 BILLING PROCEDURES FOR PROVIDING VA HEALTH SERVICES TO RESERVISTS AND NATIONAL GUARD SERVICE MEMBERS WHO DEVELOP REACTIONS TO THE SMALLPOX VACCINE

1. By direction of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) Directive 2008-047 is rescinded. VHA Directive 2008-047 is no longer necessary because the information in this Directive is available in VHA Directive 2010-051, Treatment of Active Duty and Reserve Component Servicemembers in VA Medical Facilities, and in Assistant Secretary of Defense (Health Affairs) Policy Memorandum 08-004, dated April 1, 2008.
