**RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 2008-084
NATIONAL CLINICAL REMINDER PROGRAM**

1. By direction of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) Directive 2008-084, National Clinical Reminder Program is rescinded. VHA no longer requires an established National Clinical Reminder Program.
2. Under the oversight of VHA Primary Care Operations, the VHA National Clinical Reminder committee will continue to support national clinical reminder efforts and future projects and provide recommendations to VHA leadership for awareness and action, as appropriate.
