**RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 2008-074, CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS IN
VHA QUARTERS**

1. By direction of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA), VHA Directive 2008-074, Carbon Monoxide Detectors in VHA Quarters is rescinded.
2. The carbon monoxide detection requirements previously provided in VHA Directive 2008-074 are now addressed in NFPA 101 Life Safety Code. Since the requirements are now covered by NFPA 101, it is no longer necessary to maintain a VHA Directive with similar requirements.

4. This VHA Notice will be archived as of April 30, 2019. However, the information will remain in effect.
