**RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 2006-025 OUTREACH AND CASE  
MANAGEMENT OF ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS ON PHYSICAL  
EVALUATION BOARD LIST**

1. By direction of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) the VHA Directive 2006-025, dated May 2, 2006, is rescinded. VHA no longer requires this Directive.
2. The former VHA Office of Seamless Transition previously received a list of Servicemembers who were on the Physical Evaluation Board List (PEB) from the Department of Defense (DoD). However, VA and DoD have since implemented the Integrated Disability Evaluation System (IDES) program nationwide which eliminated the need for VA to send an outreach letter when Servicemembers are going through the IDES process. In addition, VHA Liaisons for Health Care, stationed at Military Treatment Facilities routinely receive referrals from the IDES program and transition health care for Servicemembers as they transition to VA healthcare.
