Easy Access To A Pleasant Facility In Halfmoon/Clifton Park

The new Halfmoon/Clifton Park, Primary Care Practice location is intended to give you convenient and efficient access to some of the region's best health care services, and if necessary, immediate access to the fine specialists at the Stratton VA Medical Center.

Your Primary Care Provider will want to see you at least two times a year to keep you well and to detect any change in your health early.

All veterans are assigned to a Primary Care Provider. If you feel you need to see your Provider between appointments, a call to your Primary Care Provider can help you determine the best way for you to receive the care you need and to help avoid going to the Emergency Room for all but acute, emergency care.

If you need inpatient care at a VA not close enough for you and your family to commute to and from your home, accommodations are available in each VA Medical Center. They provide a place for the veteran and caregiver to stay at no charge except for meals for the caregiver. The Stratton VA Medical Center is also fortunate to have a Fisher House Comfort Home available for the families of veterans who may need to stay for an extended time near their hospitalized loved ones.

Mental Health

Maintaining good mental health is a responsibility that we all share. At times during our lives we need assistance to manage the stress and problems that can be overwhelming.

The Mental Health Practice in Clifton Park will offer individual and group counseling to veterans who have problems related to depression, anxiety, family issues or chronic problems of mental illness. Also, wellness workshops will be offered on the topics of anger management, stress management, bereavement, sleep hygiene, parenting skills and memory enhancement.


